The disciples felt exactly the same when they saw Jesus go off quietly by himself to pray up in the hills or away in the wilderness. They came to him and simply said: 'Lord, teach us to pray!' During Lent we will begin a series of evenings led by members of our different churches, exploring and discussing the way Jesus responded to the disciple's question.
