1 Corinthians 11:17-34 - How can this 'examining of ourselves' apply to us today? How do these readings in John's gospel help us see how important our relationships in the church are?

1 Corinthians 12:12-27 - Does verse 27 shed any light on the tricky bit in chapter 11:26-32?

Read the following passages:

Ephesians 1:22, 23, Ephesians 4:22-25 and Ephesians 5:22-33

Our union with other Christians in the body of Jesus has amazing implications. What speaks to you in this whole concept?
